Entry fees

The Entry Fee is \$300 for small firms up to 10 employees, \$500 for firms up to 50 employees, and \$700 for large firms. This entry fee is the only fee you will pay. The fee is paid upon completion of registering your project. Unlike other awards, there are no extra or hidden fees to pay if your project wins. Prices are in US dollars.

The fee includes the Winners benefits package and invitation to attend the Awards ceremony. Please note we do not cover incurred travel expenses.

The fee includes one sub-category of choice. A project can be submitted in multiple categories costing \$200 for each additional category.

Voting and evaluation process

Each entry is evaluated on its own merit. It is not competing against other entries. The Jury panel evaluates entries based on its creativity, form and function. The project needs to be clear on its relationship to its environment, its users, and its purpose. Creativity is not enough to be convincing; it needs to show useful function and provide a better living experience for its users, meeting the clients' expectation. Projects that demonstrate innovation and embracing new technologies, setting new trends, respecting the environment, and pushing boundaries of human ingenuity. Projects with high regard to sustainable building practises and the protection and preservation of the environment will also earn special attention from the jury.

How to enter

Entering a project is completed online on the OPAL Website, and is a simple 4 step process. Your project can be from anywhere in the world. Enter your project in one of the main disciplines; Property Development, Architectural Design or Interior Design. You will then be presented with a full range of sub-category choices, ie, Small Hotels. You can choose as many sub-categories as you deem necessary to be appropriately represented. Upload images and text description and your project is successfully registered.

Please ensure you provide sufficient and persuasive material, making your presentation as convincing as possible, this will enable the jury to make the best possible evaluation of your project. You can edit or add to your project anytime before the deadline.




Projects must be:

Please submit high quality images of your project showing multiple views and detailing of its immediate surroundings. If available, also provide floor plans or site plans.

For restoration or refurbishment projects, please include images before works commenced and after completion.

Entry categories - full list


